These monthly meetings feature a short business meeting followed by a demonstration by a local artist, or informative sessions on self-promotion, the business side of art, and gallery relations. Get Involved: It's easy to make a difference and enrich our community through art. Here are a few ways you can join us in fulfilling our mission. Please indicate how you may be interested in helping.

- Community Outreach Programs** – Lead or assist with creating or facilitating art education opportunities in Boulder schools and other community organizations (time: variable)
- Member Mini Show** – Help run the mini show at the monthly meetings. Duties include set-up, help hang and number works, distribute/collect ballots, tally ballots and take-down. Pick which month(s) you would like to help. (15-20 minutes/meeting)
- New Member Greeter** – help us welcome new members with a brief friendly phone call or email to provide basic information about our activities and member benefits. (15 minutes/month)
- Hospitality Committee** – BAA hosts two annual art shows per year and we need people to help with the receptions. Duties include menu planning, shopping/pick-up supplies, set-up reception area, set out food/bev items, restock tables and clean-up. (3-4 people/show; time: variable)
- Board Member At Large** – be a BAA Board Member and “try it on for size”. This board position does not have any responsibilities, but provides the opportunity to be involved with board discussions and planning or volunteer for small, short-term projects. (2 hours/month)
- Grants Committee** – Whether you know simple grant writing or are you interested in learning more about the process, we would welcome you on the grant committee to help raise funds for general operations and projects. (time: variable)
- Exhibit Coordinator** – Help with the production of our two annual art shows. Duties include volunteer coordination for application processing, publicity, set-up/take-down, show sitting, juror selection, awards ceremony, coordination with the hospitality committee, etc. We also welcome new opportunities for exhibitions. (time: variable)
