### ***Fear and Inertia: managing artistic blocks and anxieties***

## President's Corner

### Quote of the Month

At our January meeting, BAA member Annette Coleman demonstrated how to create artist trading cards. These "cool little miracles of miniature art" measure 3.5" x 2.5" in size and can be created in any medium on any sub-straight. Annette shared a wide range of colorful, imaginative samples. Attendees got to make trading cards and can trade their own creations the second Saturday of each month from 10 a.m. to noon at the Core New Art Space in Denver.

Once again we're discussing options for a more permanent home for BAA. The amount of commercial office space available in and around Boulder is much greater currently due to the recession. However, initial discussions among board and advisory board members indicate the need to identify and develop a consensus regarding key requirements that would drive our potential choice of space. Factors include cost, size and potential uses for the space, access to a sink, adequate parking, and duration of a lease. We'll also review lessons learned from past endeavors to find space. We invite BAA members and supporters to please feel free to contact myself or any board member with ideas and input.

As the new president of the Boulder Art Association, I'd like to share one of my initial adventures in art. When our kids went off to college, I found myself roaming around the house after my work day looking for things to do and started studying and creating mixed media art on canvas, full of energy and color. My creations included everything from beads and acrylics to wire, wood, fabric and shells. One day, a short blurb in the Boulder Daily Camera asked, "Are you so artsy you should be on TV?" to which I answered to myself, "yes!" Next thing I knew a TV production crew spent the day in my downstairs studio filming a segment for HGTV.

Despite cold temperatures and a landscape that's far less colorful than summertime in Colorado, I'm struck with the beauty of our winter landscapes as I walk, drive, and bike around Boulder. The bare bones of plants and trees against the white snow as well as our blue skies provide rich and inspiring material for watercolor, oil, acrylic, photography, or any type of art. The stunning variety of light and shadows throughout the day just expands opportunities to create and enjoy. Winter hibernation is fine for awhile, but why not turn off the TV and get out there and make some art to beat those winter doldrums! And while you're at it bring some of your creations to the next BAA meeting to share with the rest of us.

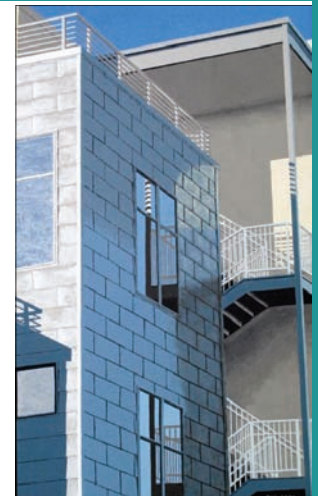

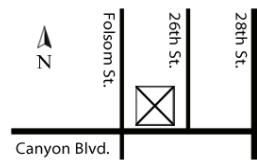

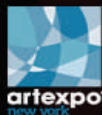

A unique aspect of the altered books that I make is that they unveil a deeper meaning, relating content of the selected book to the topic I am exploring. Sculptors may provide their own bases or prearrange to have them provided. All art must remain in the show until June 13, 4:00 P.M. and we must be vacated by 6P.M. Storage is not available. All submitting artists are required to work the show for one 2 hour period.

**Limitations:** 4 pieces of artwork and unlimited bin work with protective wrapping including cards can be entered. Small pieces of framed artwork (14" and under) can be considered as bin work. All items must be clearly identified with artist's name, price and an inventory number. *Please submit an itemized bin work sheet with every piece of work listed on the sheet when delivered.*
